**Your TSP Account – What to Think About When Nearing Retirement or Considering Leaving the Government -- Tuesday, October 3, 2017 – 2:00 pm to 4:00pm** The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) and the Federal Retirement Thrift Investment Board are co-sponsoring this program at the SEC, 100 F Street, NE, Washington, DC 20549 and via public webcast. This event is open to all federal employees and members of the uniformed services who may be considering retiring or leaving Federal Service. The program will cover TSP distribution options, withdrawals and roll-outs. Discussion will also cover fees, the common red flags of investment fraud, how to check out a financial professional, and questions to ask when thinking about moving funds from the TSP.
